3. **A good budget keeps you honest.** Documenting purchases allows you to identify the leaks in your budget because you weren't keeping tabs on where the money was going.
4. **Budgeting helps improve habits.** What you measure, you can improve. If you spend more than you earn, you will drain your savings.
5. **Budgeting helps you avoid debt and improve credit.** By truly understanding how much it costs to be you, you can make adjustments to stop living from paycheck to paycheck.
