- 1) John and his sister Carol were making cupcakes for their classrooms for Friday. John made 26 for his class and Carol made 27 for her class. It was raining and while they were walking to school. On the way Carol tripped and she dropped one of her boxes of cup cakes that had 6 cup cakes in the box and the cupcakes rolled down the sidewalk and a skunk, a squirrel and a dog quickly ran and ate them. How many cup cakes were left between the brother and sister?

- 2) Danny had saved up \$230 and had it in the top drawer of his dresser in a small envelope. He has always wanted to have a drone to fly. The drone cost \$128. His uncle Mike that morning gave him \$40 for his birthday. He took the money out for the drone, how much money did Danny have after he purchased the Drone?

- 3) Carl and Amanda were camping together. Carl caught 22 fish and Amanda caught 5 more fish than Carl. They kept the fish in a container with water to keep the fish alive. They cooked 4 of the fish they caught. That evening while they were asleep in the tent a bear came into their camp ground and took 7 fish out of the container. How many fish did they have the next morning?

- 4) Forrest Gump likes to run. He would run every day during the week. He ran 10 miles on Monday, 8 miles on Tuesday, 12 miles on Wednesday, 10 miles on Thursday and 18 miles on Friday. The second week he ran the same number of miles each day except Wednesday he didn't run at all. The third week he ran the same number of miles each day that he ran the first week except he didn't run on Monday. How many miles did he run that first week? How many did he run the second week? How many miles did he run each week? How many miles total did he run?

- 5) Went to the animal shelter where there were 24 dogs total. We wanted to adopt a dog but couldn't decide on which one as they are all so cute. There were 3 cages containing two dogs in each cage because they were brothers or brother and sister, if you like one you had to adopt both of them to keep them happy, that made sense. We went back the next day and the 3 cages were empty of two dogs each and so were 4 other cages. How many dogs were left for us to decide upon?
