$2\frac{3}{20}$

5)  $5\frac{1}{4} - 2\frac{1}{5} =$

$3\frac{1}{20}$

6)  $8\frac{1}{3} - 2\frac{1}{5} =$

$6\frac{2}{15}$

7)  $7\frac{1}{2} - 4\frac{1}{5} =$

$3\frac{3}{10}$
