Example 1 $\frac{1}{2} \div \frac{7}{10} = \frac{1 \times 10}{2 \times 7} = \frac{10}{14} = \frac{5}{7}$

Example 2 $\frac{1}{3} \div \frac{3}{10} = \frac{1 \times 10}{3 \times 3} = \frac{10}{9} = 1\frac{1}{9}$
