The students split up into groups of 4 there were 20 students altogether in the class.

- 1) A group of five boys in one group from the class saw 25 monkeys playing in their enclosure. 14 of the monkeys were in the trees and the rest were sitting on a large rock eating bananas. What fractions of the money were in the trees?

- 2) A group of five girls where standing in front of the two bird cage enclosures. They saw 20 birds total. Eight of the birds in the second cage were eagles. What fraction of the birds at the two cages at the zoo where eagles?

- 3) A second group of five girls where at the petting zoo. They were able to pet 4 of the sheep but the other 25 sheep were busy eating and did not come over to meet the girls. What fraction of sheep were the girls petting?

- 4) The next groups of five girls were at the elephant's enclosure. There were 7 elephants in the enclosure and 3 of the elephants came over to meet the girls as they saw the girls had peanuts them to feed the elephants. What Fraction of elephants came over to see the girls?
