CREATING USING MICROSOFT POWER POINT

- 1) Download Power Point from website.
- 2) Save in a folder you know you may work in with the name (MATH PICTURE LESSONS) (click on **Enable Editing**) to make changes.
- 3) You will discover two examples lessons above.
 - a. You may modify those two lesson to your liking.
- 4) If you are going to create your own new lessons
 - a. Choose layout and blank for your lesson.
 - b. Go to Google and determine what you wish to use in your lesson. Click on image at the top.
 - c. Use snipping tool to copy and paste image to your power point or Control V to copy and Control P to paste.
 - d. Adjust size of object and if needed delete background of object
 - 1. HOW TO DELETE BACK GROUND
 - 2. Double click on picture of object
 - 3. Look in the upper left corner of menu
 - 4. Click on remove background adjust the arrows on your object.
 - 5. Click on Control D to duplicate image.
 - 6. Place a text of + -= X/ what ever you wish to use in your lesson. Make sure the text is big enough. Highlight text and click on Control D to duplicate text.
- 5) When puzzle is almost finished. Go to Insert objects rectangle. Click on shape fill (no fill) t. Shape outline color black and then click on weight and make thicker.
- 6) Repeat the process above for both lessons to place on the lesson page.
- 7) Open up BLANK WORD DOCUMENT FOR YOUR LESSON
- 8) Click Enable editing to adjust delete the two examples
- 9) Use Snipping tool to paste to document. Click on the image you just pasted and use wrap text in front of text.
- 10) Click on Boarder and use simple boarder.
- 11) Repeat 8 through 10 for the second image.
- 12) Save your lesson. Depending on who your doing this for save in your folder and send it or just print out hard copy.
