2) They were decorating the Christmas tree. It took them two days to complete the decoration. They placed 25 Christmas balls the first day and another 25 the second day? How many Christmas tree balls were on the tree after two days? 25 + 25 =



3) The detective was searching for clues. He found 11 clues the first day and 12 the next day. How many clues did he find in all? 11 + 12 =



4) Frankenstein dropped into the school playground during recess. There were 45 students in the playground until some of the students saw Frankenstein. 20 students screamed as they ran back into the school. No one told the other students or the teacher. How many students were left on the playground? 45-20=



5) There were 5 canoes with 2 Indians in each canoe going down the river. How many Indians total were going down the river? 2+2+2+2+2=
