## Matter - Solids, Liquids, & Gases

Everything in the world is made up of matter. There are three kinds of matter.

1. **SOLIDS** are hard, and you can see a solid.
  - a. Examples Football, baseball, building,
2. **LIQUIDS** a liquid is not hard.
  - a. Examples are soda, milk, water
3. **GAS** – It is not a liquid or a solid. You can't see gas.
  - a. Helium. Hydrogen, Freon, Natural gas.
