- 1. <u>SOLIDS</u> are hard, and you can see a solid.
 - a. Examples Football, baseball, building,
- 2. <u>LIQUID</u>s a liquid is not hard.
 - a. Examples are soda, milk, water
- 3. <u>GAS</u> It is not a liquid or a solid. You can't see gas.
 - a. Helium. Hydrogen, Freon, Natural gas.
