- President 14 9 24 15 14 began the withdrawal of U.S. troops from Vietnam. _____
- The 16 1 18 9 19 Peace Accords on "Ending the War and Restoring Peace in Vietnam" were signed on January 27, 1973 officially ending direct U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War. _____
- In 1976, Vietnam was reunited as one nation under 3 15 13 13 21 14 9 19 20 rule.
