1. The 14-1-22-9-7-1-20-9-15-14 Act said that shipping had to be done with Britain to make sure they made money.
2. The 16-18-15-3-12-1-13-1-20-9-15-14 of 1763 prohibited settlement west of the Appalachian Mountains.
3. The 17-21-1-18-20-5-18-9-14-7 Act forced colonists to house soldiers and give them food.
4. 23-18-9-20-19 15-6 1-19-19-9-19-20-1-14-3-5 were unlimited search warrants looking for smuggled goods.
5. The 19-21-7-1-18 Act lowered the tax on molasses to try and stop smuggling.
6. The 19-20-1-13-16 Act was a tax on all printed material.
7. The 4-5-3-12-1-18-1-20-15-18-25 Act gave the British parliament the right to tax and make decisions for the colonies "in all cases".
