

Google Tour Builder

This lesson may prove to become one of your finest lessons over time.

This course is designed to be completed in 12.5 hours or more depending on the difficulty of your lessons. You are required to create one (1) lesson. The area of your lesson will be determined by what subject and grade level you are currently teaching I do not now or ever ask a educator to create a lesson they will never use. You may wish to use this lesson in your classroom which will provide your students with an outstanding example of what they may do if you assign this to them. This lesson is also an outstanding tool allowing you to demonstrate to students many different ideas, activities and history going on in the world.

This course is designed to provide you with an easier method of teaching and assist in facilitating lessons with students that have a problem learning. You will not have a face-to-face meetings or online chat sessions with this course. The website will provide you with all the instructions necessary with an example and videos.

You will discover over time that your students will be looking forward to this lesson allowing them to fully express what they have learned if they are going to create their own lesson.

First let's get to know the parts of the lesson and how they work together.

1) Choose a theme that involves is going to be beneficial for your class. Area of interest, historical location something similar in concept. If you wish to travel Europe or Asia, Washington DC or New York City and may Disney Land those also would work.

2) It is important to create a folder in your Google drive or your computer, where you may store everything you need and are able to find it quickly and add to it to your tour.

3) Open up a google document or Microsoft word allowing you to type information and locations of your Tour. Place at least one paragraph per

location explaining what is being shown there. This Paragraph means no less than three complete sentences. And should be accompanied with a photo or several.

4) Figure out where you will start and search for a Google image or use one of your own and place that photo at the beginning. You should place all photos you will need for the tour in your folder. You may create sub folders for each travel point YOU WILL NEED AT LEAST four (4) locations.

5)TRAVEL POINTS. a. You will need to place at the very least 3 of each Location. Place these in your folder ahead of time. b. You must place at least one street visit per location. c. You must write at least one paragraph per location.

I believe you will discover that none of the above is difficult but if you use this as an example for your students it will make your job not only easier but more fun.

Please email me your phone number, name of your school and grade level and subject upon registering for the class. I will provide a call to clear up any questions you may have. Registration may take place at any time during the year. There is not a set beginning or end time. You must finish by the date we have posted on the Course web page. Teachers may choose to take (start) this class at any time prior to the ending date. The span of time needed to complete the course is normally three weeks from the date that you start the class.
