## Creating A QR Code Lesson

## CREATING QR CODE USING WORD

- 1. Open up word 2010 or newer
- 2. Hit your enter key 4 times to create a buffer
- 3. Insert word art at the top or type in a heading of your choice describing what the lesson is about.
- 4. Click on the tab that says Page Layout
  - a. Page Color Fill Effects- Texture Stationary
  - b. Do not choose a color for a background
  - c. Background needs to be easy to read.
  - d. Change margins or paper orientation if necessary.
- 5. Create a table to place your questions in or math problems. THIS IS OPTIONAL.
- 6. Design your lesson.
- 7. Click on the link that creates a QR code.
  - a. Place your answers in the space provided to create the code
  - b. Your QR will appear.
  - c. You may double check your work by scanning the QR right now to make sure it is correct. If not make necessary corrections.

## COPY QR CODE TO DOCUMENT

- 1. Click the download button download QR Code as JPEG
- 2. Choose Open when it appears at bottom of screen
- 3. Click on the word File at the top menu of the QR Code window.
- 4. Click copy or Ctrl C to copy and then paste the QR Code in your lesson.
- 5. Double click the QR Code grab the handles (little circles) that appear and make the code smaller if needed.
- 6. Click Wrap Text and tight with the QR Code highlighted allowing you to now move the code to where you want it.
