These are the numbers that the following runners wore for the marathon. The runners are: Connie, Alice, Joey, Sandy, Penny and Tommy.

There were 3,500 runners in the marathon and they all wore a different number. The runners all got their numbers in the order that they signed in the day of the race. So the first person to sign in got the number 1 and the last person to sign in got the number 3,500.

1. Of the group of six, Penny had the lowest number.
2. The digit in the tens place on Alice is one more higher than the tens place on Tommy's
3. Sandy was the last person of the group to sign in for the race.
4. Joey and Tommy were closest to each other in line.
5. Connie's number is lower than Joey
