MAC USERS

- 1) When finished coloring

 - b) If your link is open and word is open you may switch between the two programs by clicking on the F3 key at the top of the keyboard.

- 1. How to copy the whole screen to word
 - a) Shift Control Command keys and the number <mark>3</mark>.
 - b) Transfer to the Word document and then **Command V** to paste.
- 2. How to copy a selected section of the screen to word.
 - a) Shift Control Command keys and the number <mark>4</mark>
 - b) Transfer to the Word document and the **Command V** to paste
 - Placing your name in the header
 - a) Documents and Elements--Click on HEADER --Third one over type In your name and grade.

WINDOW USERS
