

Lesson 9 Creating a Pictograph

1. Open or find whatever you are working with for this lesson.
2. If it is M&Ms sort and count them by color.
3. Place color at the bottom of the page.
4. Decide on number of units per color
5. Decide on the left what each column should represent numbers
(Example: Each Row is by 2)
6. Place an icon representing the number per column of that particular color. **EXAMPLE LISTED BELOW**
