This course is designed to provide educators with ability to create a lesson that is fun in doing for students and helps with learning..

*The website that I have created will provide you with all the instructions needed with examples. Please email me your phone number, Name of school and what grade or subject you teach, upon registering for the class. I will provide a call to clear up any questions you may have. Registration may take place at any time during the year. You must finish by the date we have posted on the Classes web page “Classes”. Teachers may choose to take (start) this class at any time prior to the ending date. The span of time needed to complete the course is normally **three** weeks from the date that you start the class. If you need more time just email me to adjust with you.*

*When you go to the WORD WALL WEBSITE you may create **5 free lessons**. Only **3 are needed for this course**.*

Depending on your grade level and subject You may wish your students to create a lesson. *If you are teaching multiple disciplines such as in elementary school you **may** provide three (3) different lessons example (Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts). If you are teaching one discipline in Middle and High school. You need to create **three (3)** lessons for your subject.*

(Each lesson may be emailed to me by sending me the link and name to each lesson.) This will allow me to place your lesson on the website and obtain the full effect of what you created.’
